





DIPLOMA IN PSYCHOSEXUAL AND MARRIAGE THERAPY

For many years now the Orthodox communities in the UK and further afield have acknowledged the lack of marriage counsellors and therapists for the community and provided by observant counsellors within the community. Several years ago a pilot programme was run successfully at a Fertility Service for the community in London, with the support of its Dayan. Most of its graduates have become qualified marriage counsellors with the inclusion of problems presented within marriage including those of an intimate nature.

We shall commence such dedicated training for the community as a whole will commence in London, from June 2020 and we have enlisted the support of Rabbi Mordechai Nissim as course consultant.



Schedule: This training is scheduled over one three day block per month in year 1, Sunday afternoons to evening and Mondays and Tuesday during the day (eighteen days per year, total 36 days over 2 years) Year 2 is Sunday/Monday. The training is accredited by the National Council for Psychotherapy (NCP), COSRT, the Professional Standards Board (via NCS) and Middlesex University.

For whom is it: The training is intended for Rabbis and Rebbetzin, medical staff, psychotherapists, psychologists, counsellors, midwives, match makers and those who run marriage preparation classes.

Course participants are women and men, experienced in working with people. During the training the more sensitive discussions may be held in separate seating arrangements for women and men in accordance with Halacha.
